### For B. Pharm & M. Pharm:

These regulations cover areas such as Curriculum Structure, Syllabus, Scheme of Instruction, Scheme of Examination, Scheme of Evaluation & other Regulation of the affiliating University like Grading Systems, Attendance requirements, and Code of Conduct for students and faculty.

The regulations are periodically updated from time to time as per the instructions of affiliating University to align with the technological advancements, so as to maintain academic discipline, promote fairness in evaluation, and support continuous improvement in Higher Education.

#### ➤ **Grading System:**

- ✓ BST follows a Credit-based Grading system of MAKAUT, where letter Grades like O (Outstanding), E (Excellent), A (very Good), B (Good), C (Fair), D (Below average), F (Fail) & I (Incomplete) correspond to specific grade points.
- ✓ The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is used to evaluate overall performance.

#### ➤ **Examination Rules:**

- ✓ These include regulations on Internal Assessments/ Continuous Assessment (CAs), End-Semester Examinations, minimum attendance requirements (75%) etc.
- ✓ The Internal & External examinations are conducted as per the norms laid down in the academic calendar of the affiliating University.
- ✓ All the Examination halls are under CCTV surveillance, which the University can watch the examination process live.

- ✓ The primary objective is to uphold academic discipline, ensure fairness in assessment, and foster continuous improvement in the institution's educational practices.


## ➤ Eligibility for Admission

## ➤ Duration of the Course

- ✓ The D. Pharm course is of **Two years duration**, followed by **500 hours of practical training** spread over a minimum of **3 months** in approved Hospital or Community Pharmacy.

## ➤ Attendance Requirement

- ✓ Minimum **75% attendance** in both Theory and Practical classes is mandatory.
- ✓ Shortage of attendance may lead to detention from examinations.
- ✓ Genuine medical or emergency leave must be supported with appropriate documentation and may be considered at the discretion of the head of the Institution.
