- All answer sheets of the end semester examinations are scanned at central hub in the University campus and are uploaded in the secure online portal.
- Scripts are anonymized (masked), pooled centrally, and assigned randomly to examiners across colleges, enabling remote evaluation.
- Examiners log in via unique user IDs and passwords, marking scripts electronically on-screen. This is called Digital valuation.
